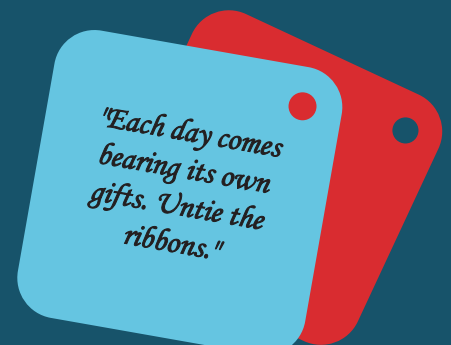

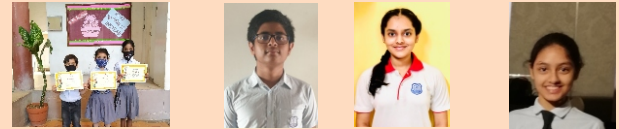

Output:- Students enjoyed reciting the poem with clay spider by doing actions too.



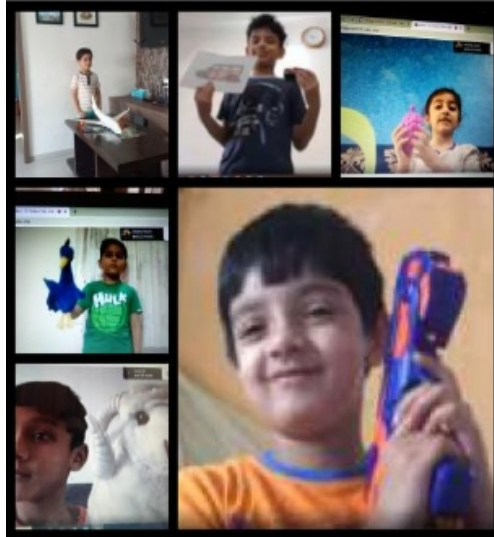
