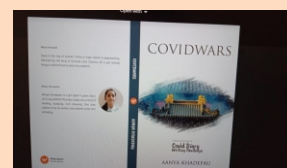
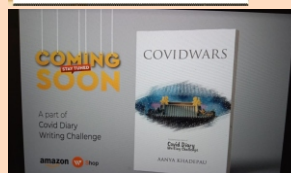

Tanish Thakkar of Std.12 Commerce participated in Sound of Music a vocal competition and secured First position.

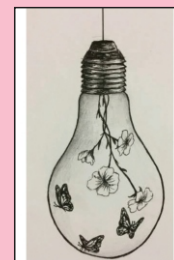
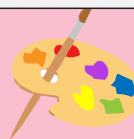
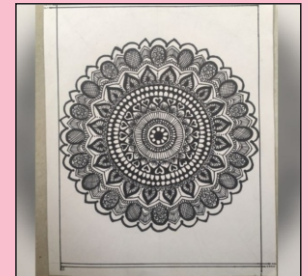
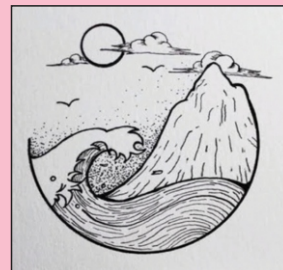

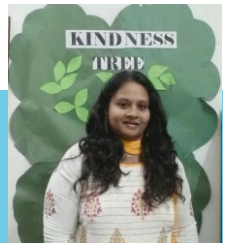
Art Heals
