Vision

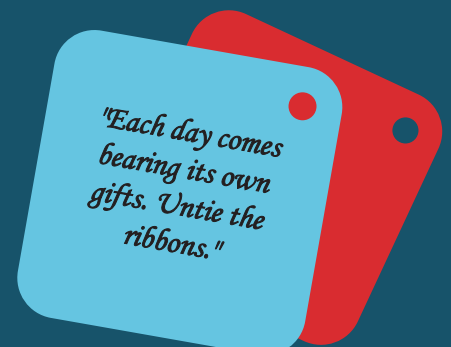

COMPASSION IS HIGHEST OF VIRTUES



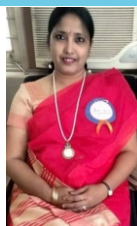
