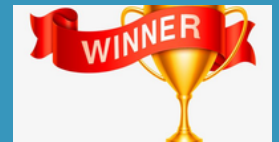


**RUNNERS UP TROPHY**

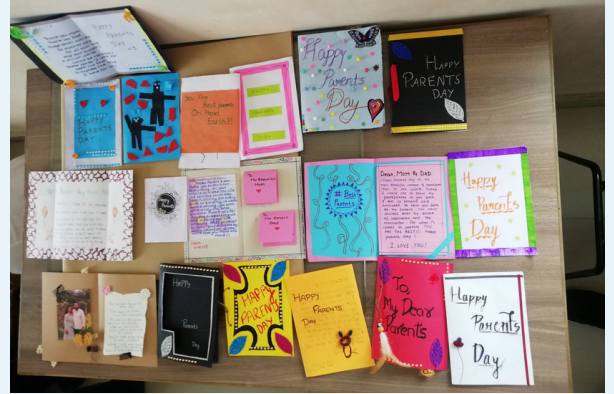
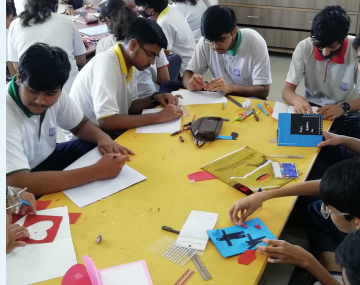




# STD. 9-12 CELEBRATIONS
